STARPOWER IGBT Power Module provides ultra low conduction loss as well as short circuit ruggedness. They are designed for the applications such as general inverters and UPS.



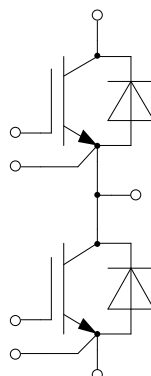

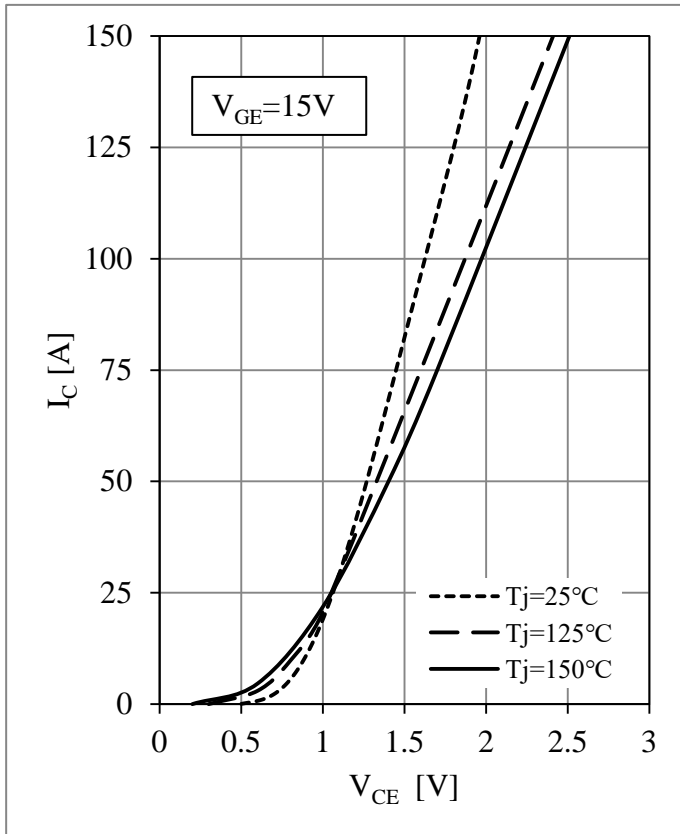


Fig 1. IGBT Output Characteristics

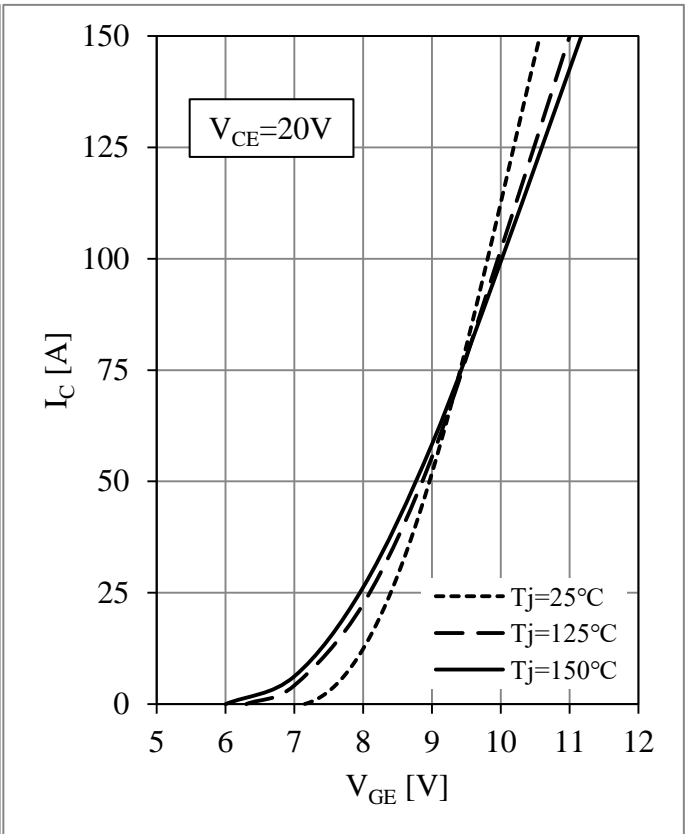


Fig 2. IGBT Transfer Characteristics

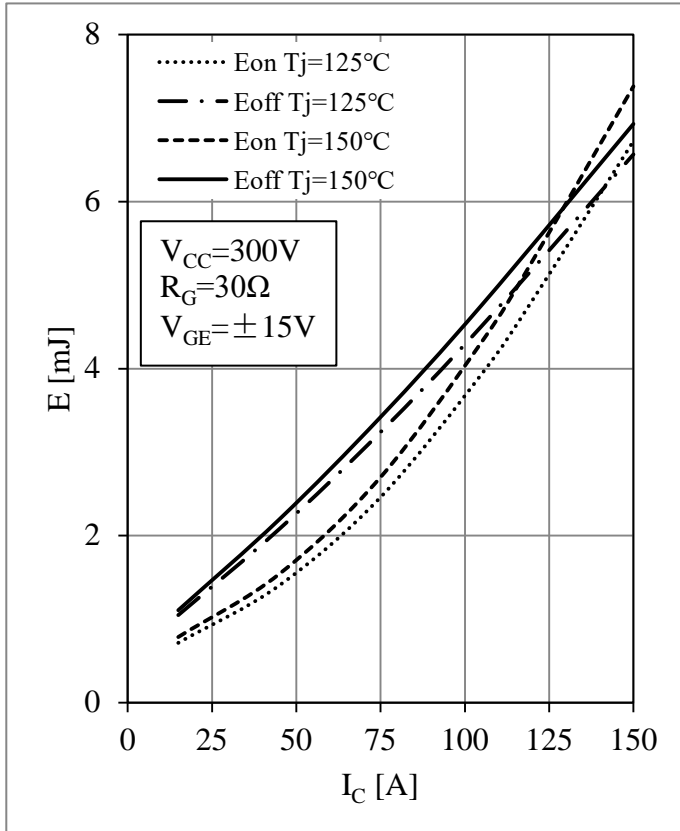


Fig 3. IGBT Switching Loss vs. I_C

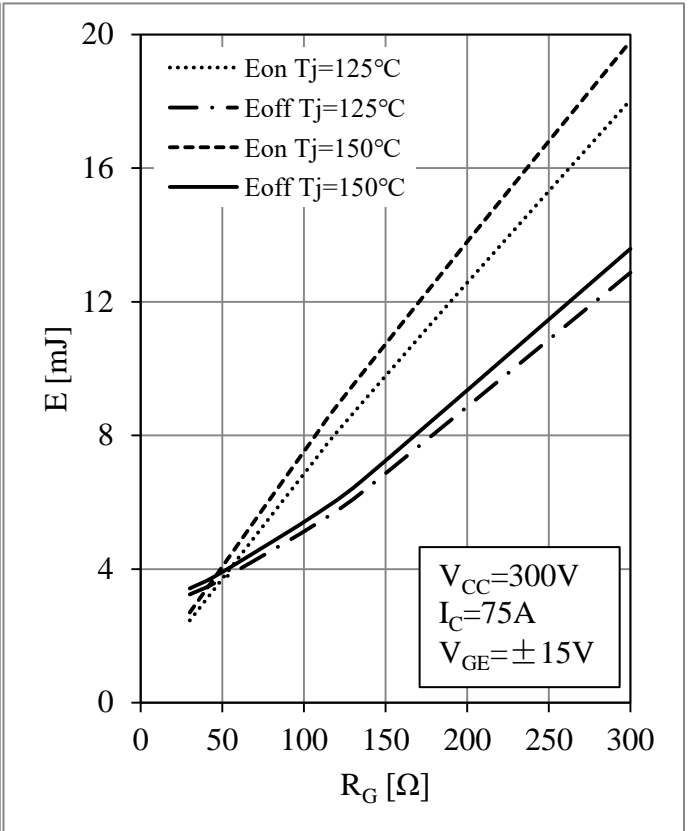


Fig 4. IGBT Switching Loss vs. R_G

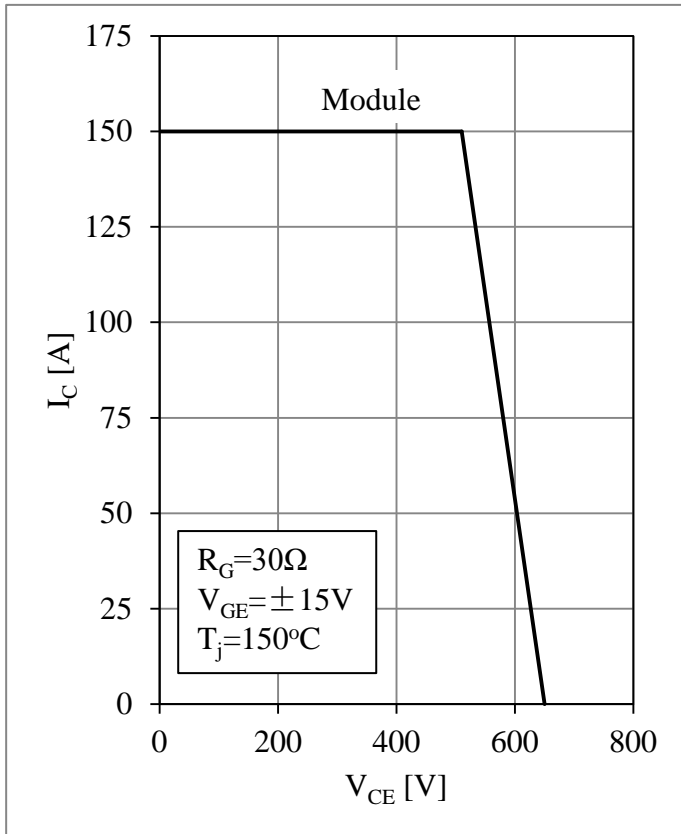


Fig 5. RBSOA

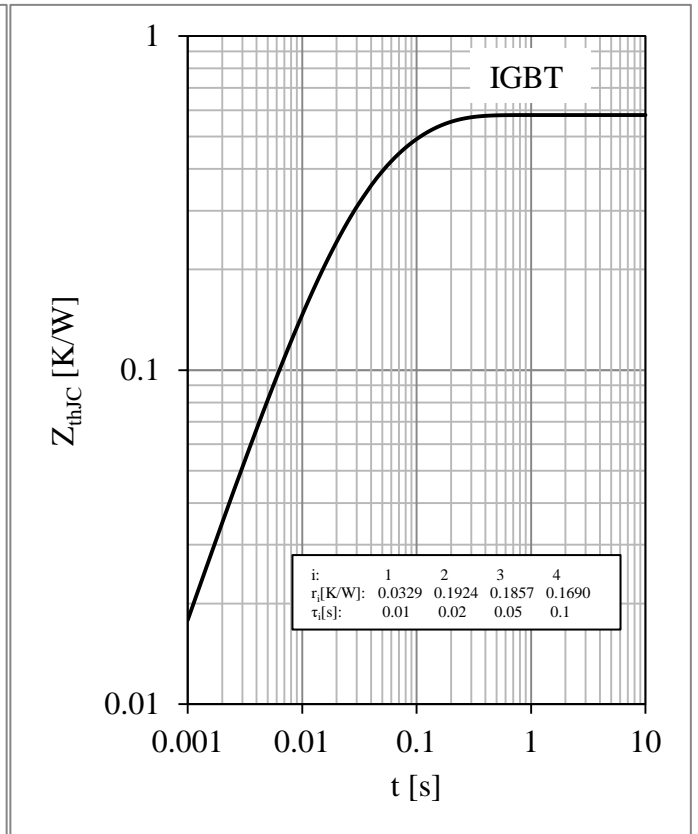


Fig 6. IGBT Transient Thermal Impedance

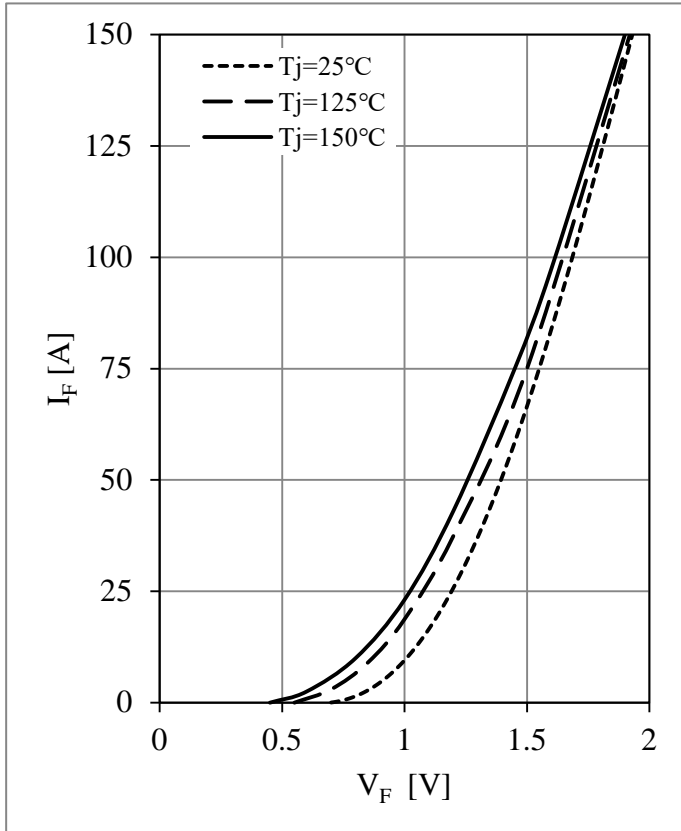


Fig 7. Diode Forward Characteristics

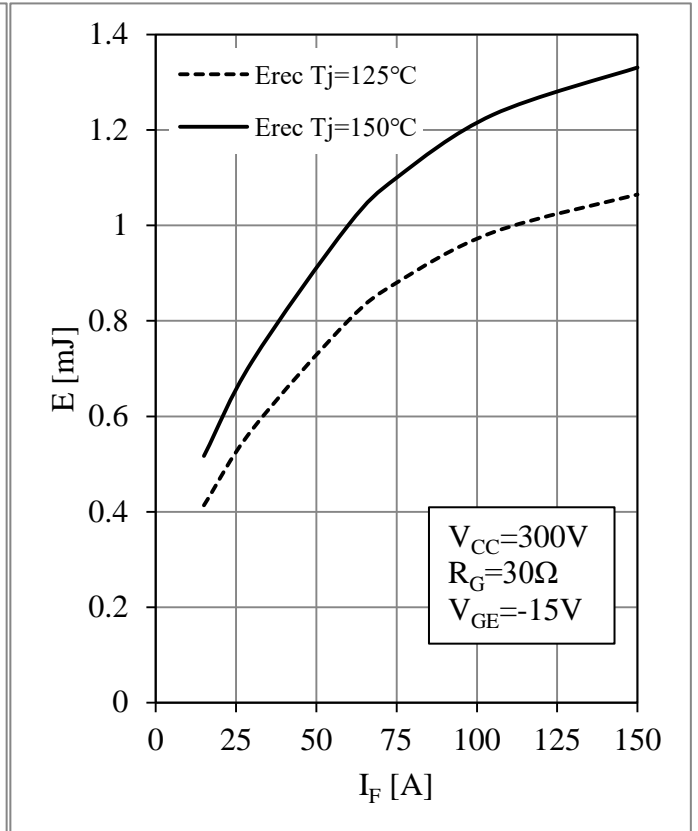


Fig 8. Diode Switching Loss vs. I_F

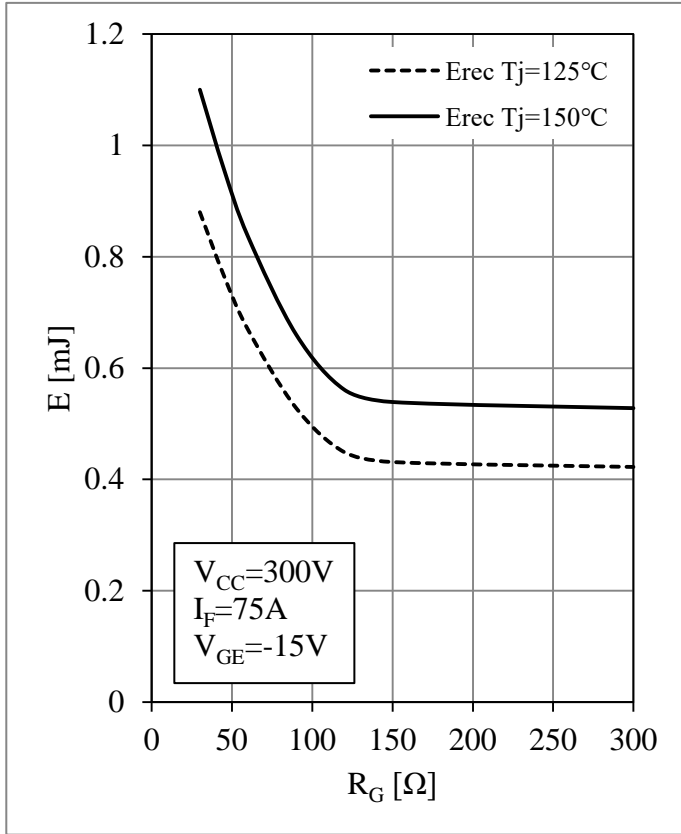


Fig 9. Diode Switching Loss vs. R_G

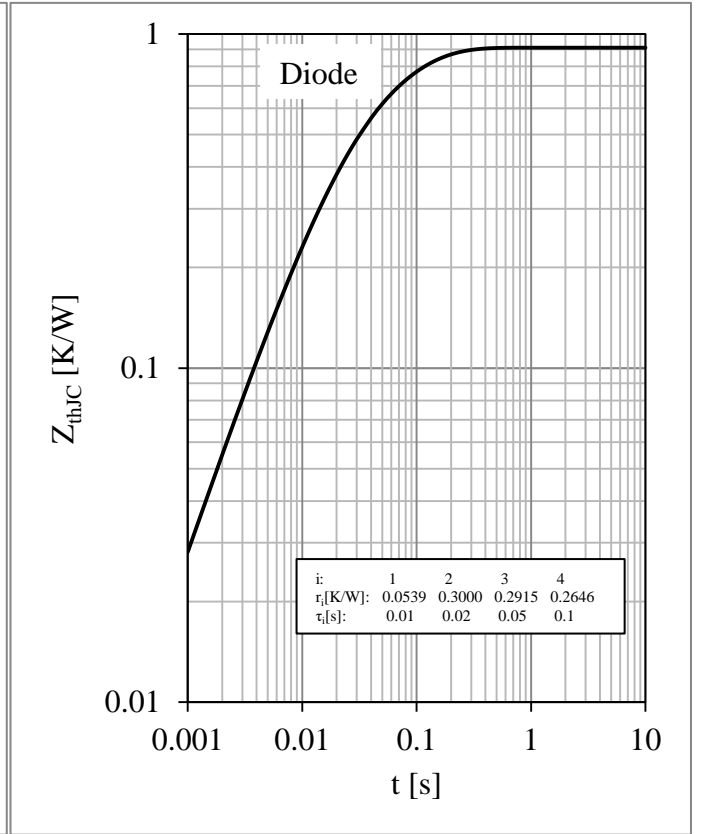
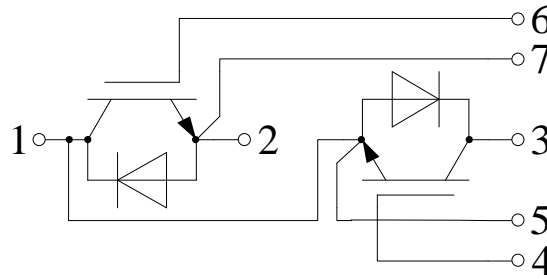


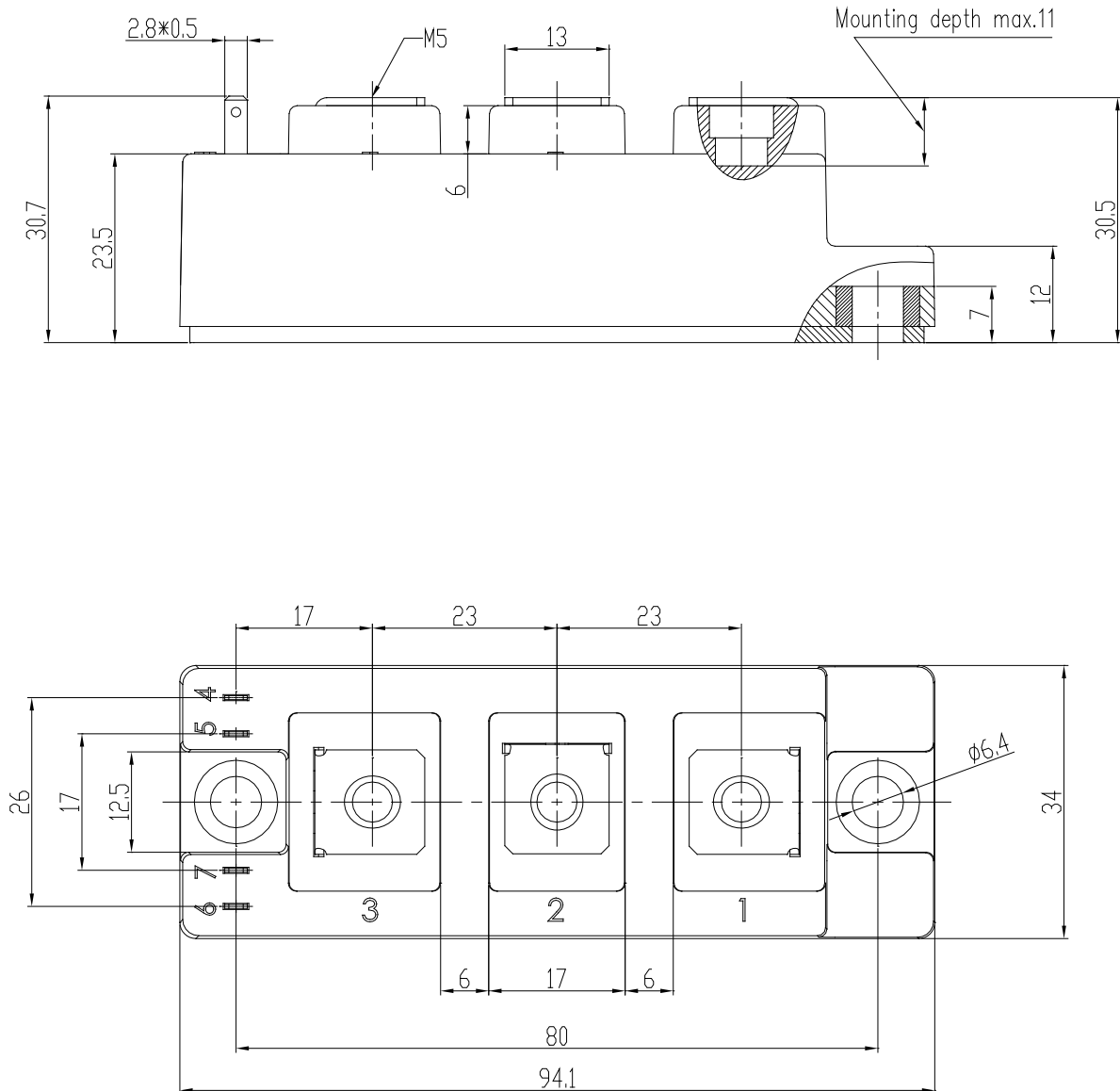
Fig 10. Diode Transient Thermal Impedance
